SAFARI OVERVIEW

DAY 1

WINDHOEK TO ETOSHA NATIONAL PARK

Main Destination: Etosha National Park
Accommodation: Toshari Lodge (Mid-range)
Meals: Lunch & Dinner

Start your journey with a morning departure from Windhoek. After a briefing, head to Etosha National Park for an afternoon game drive, where you'll have your first chance to spot elephants, giraffes, and other wildlife. Overnight at Toshari Lodge.

DAY 2

FULL-DAY SAFARI IN ETOSHA NATIONAL PARK

Main Destination: Etosha National Park
Accommodation: Toshari Lodge (Mid-range)
Meals: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

Spend the day exploring Etosha's waterholes, known for prime wildlife sightings. Early morning and late afternoon drives offer the best views of animals. Return to Toshari Lodge for a relaxing evening.

DAY 3

ETOSHA NATIONAL PARK TO SWAKOPMUND

Main Destination: Swakopmund
Accommodation: Hotel À la Mer or similar
Meals: Breakfast & Lunch

Travel from Etosha to Swakopmund, where you can enjoy optional coastal activities like sandboarding or a dolphin cruise (own cost). Spend the night exploring Swakopmund's coastal charm.

DAY 4

RETURN TO WINDHOEK VIA OKAHANDJA CRAFT MARKET

Main Destination: Windhoek
Meals: Breakfast & Lunch

Begin the journey back to Windhoek, stopping at the Okahandja Wood Carving Market to pick up local crafts. Arrive in Windhoek in the afternoon, marking the end of your tour.
